

How to store pesticides safely?

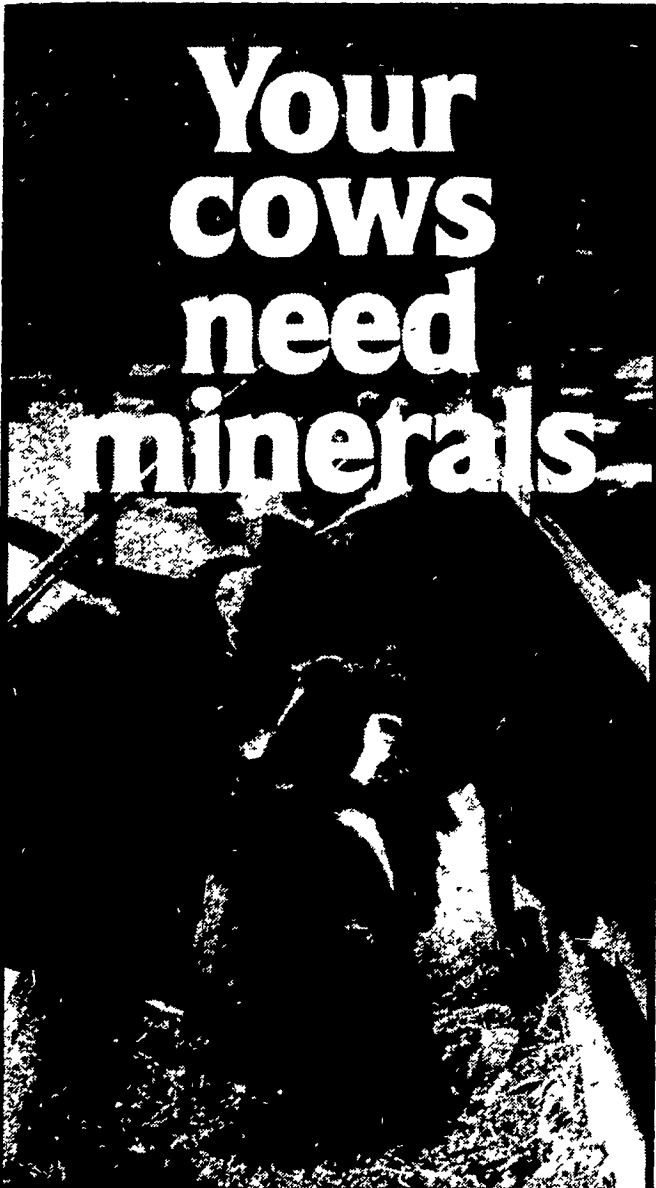
MEDIA — The usefulness of a pesticide may be lost with time and the methods used for storage.

This information represents general ranges, since shelf life is determined by storage conditions, stability and formulation.

James J. McKeehen, Delaware County Extension Agricultural Agent advises you keep tem-

peratures below 100° Fahrenheit and do not allow liquids to freeze. Retain materials in original containers, tightly sealed. Every chemical company contacted recommended not storing pesticides longer than two years; in fact, most companies will not take back their products after this time.
