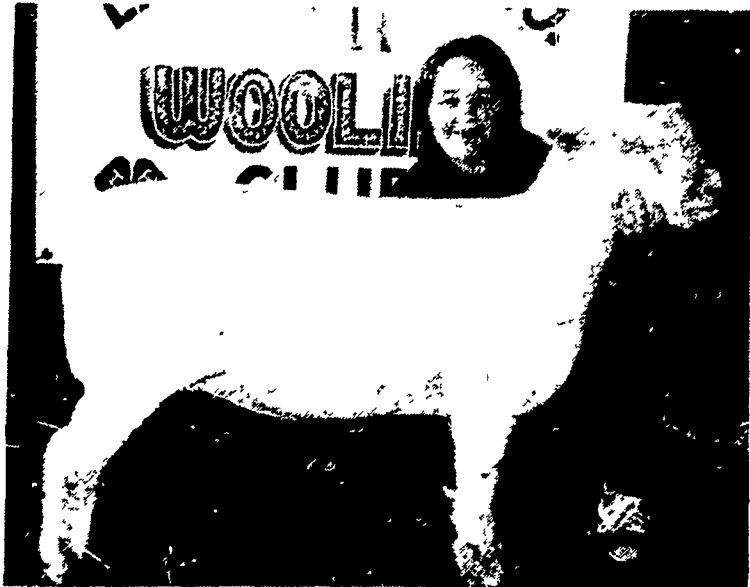


Rohrer wins titles

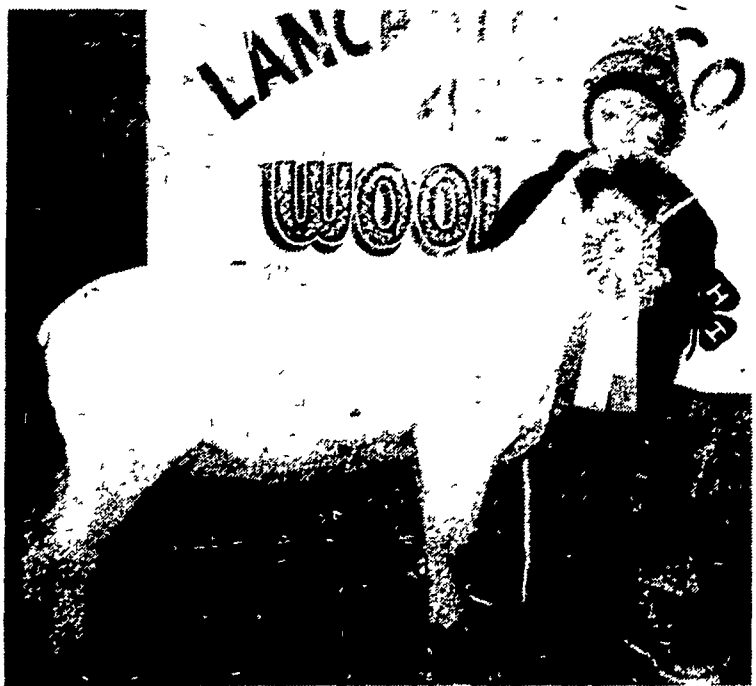

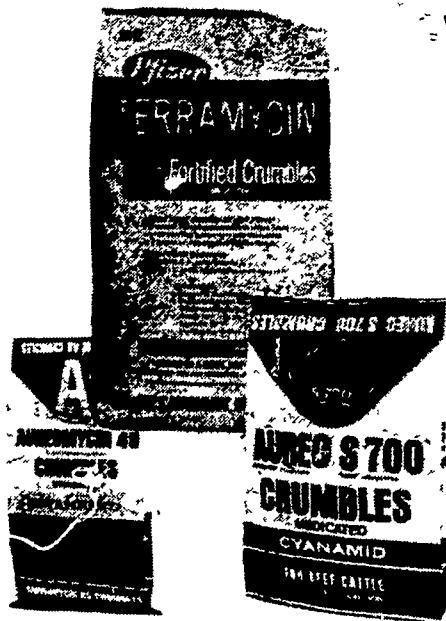

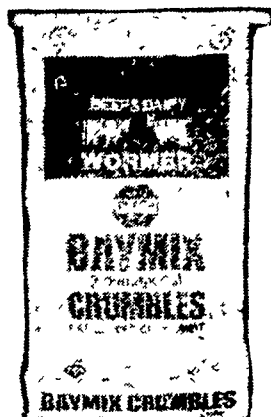
