Compared to last week slaughter steers closed .50 to 1.00 higher. Heifers 1.00, instances 1.50 higher. Cows steady to 1.00 higher and bulls steady to 2.00 higher. Slaughter steer and heifer prices advanced early in the week influenced by the late rally in the carcass beef prices the previous week. By midweek a lower trading and unsettled meat trade caused buyers to halt to remove part of the early weeks advancement of live prices. Receipts this week about 3100 as compared to 2676 a week ago and 3647 last year.

Bulls steady. Slaughter supply mainly Choice and Choice and Prime 2-4 slaughter steers, around 40% heifers and 10% cows.
