The Holiday interrupted weak showed fairly good demand, except for yield grade 4 Steers and Heifers, despite Monday receipts of over 6800 head and near 2900 head Tuesday. Heifers were largely steady Monday but trended down Tuesday. The dressed beef trended lower early. Slaughter steers made up 47 pct of the three

day supply; Heifers 38 pct. Cows 1 pct; Feeders 7 pct.
