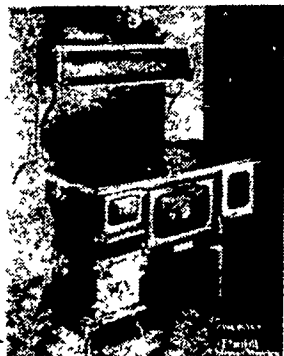
Three delegates will attend the convention in Harrisburg. They are: Ruth Shaub, Mildred Pfautz, and Barbara Wenger.

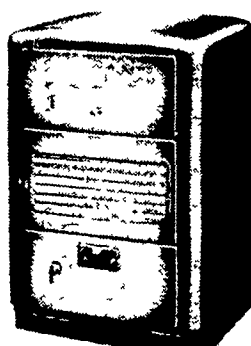
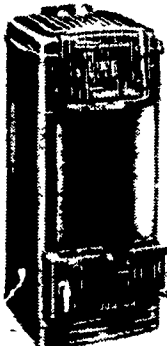
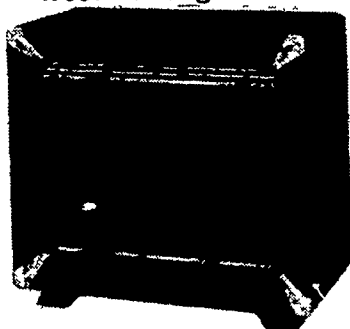


Enterprise Queen Cook Stove

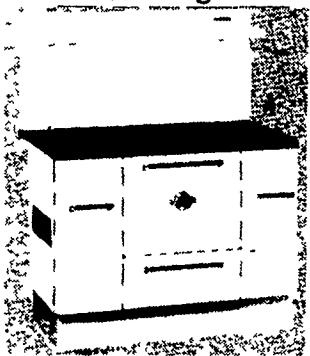

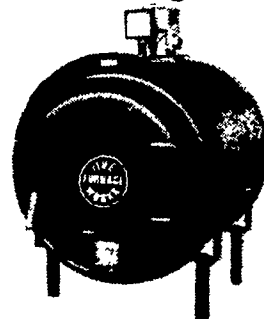

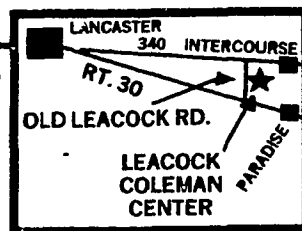
