LANCASTER — Pennsylvania's potato queen, 17-year-old Gail Graybill, will turn her crown over to a new queen on January 14 in conjunction with the 65th Annual Pennsylvania State Farm Show.

Gail, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. J. Clair Graybill of Lancaster, was raised and worked on her parents farm which included 50 acres of potatoes.

This young queen attended the Manheim Central High School, being active in Future Homemakers of America, served as a Red Cross volunteer, a cheerleader, a yearbook editor,

and member of the Medical Careers Club. She plans a future in accounting.

To date, Gail has traveled over 2,000 miles and made over 20 appearances at shopping malls, state fairs, and other gatherings. She has distributed over 10,000 potato recipe booklets, and hundreds of pounds of potato chips.

The Pennsylvania Co-operative Potato Growers, Inc. is now seeking donations for the queen and promotional activities which then will be listed at the annual banquet, Thursday, January 14, 1982.

The Champion Medium Weight steer weighing 1050 pounds sold for \$1.10 per pound and was bought by Chapman Equipment Center, Wescosville. The steer was exhibited by Diane Krause, Lehigh County. Debra Krause showed the Reserve Champion Medium Weight steer, weighing 1086 pounds. It was purchased by both Marvin Clause Home Improvement and T. Kern's Floor Covering, both of Slatington, for \$1 per pound.

The Grand Champion individual lamb, weighing 102 pounds was sold at \$3.90 per pound to Danny George, George's Foodliner. It was owned by David Schultz, Northampton County. The Grand Champion Pair of Lambs, exhibited by Susan Breninger, Lehigh County, was purchased by Haftl Meats, Allentown. The Pair of Lambs weighed 182 pounds and was sold at \$1.75 per pound.

Marilyn Stroh, Montgomery County, showed the Reserve Grand Champion Lamb and was sold to Southeast Farm Credit, Silverdale, at \$1.40 per pound. The lamb weighed 94 pounds. The Reserve Grand Champion Pair of Lambs, shown by Ruth Grim, Lehigh County, weighed 190 pounds. It was purchased by Danny George, George's Foodliner, for \$1.20 per pound. The Champion Heavy Weight lamb was purchased by Berks-Lehigh Farm Credit, Fogelsville, for \$1.15 per pound. The lamb weighed 140 pounds and was exhibited by Joshua Grim, Lehigh County. The Reserve Champion Heavy Weight lamb, weighing 135 pounds was sold at \$1.25 per pound to Chapman Equipment Center, Wescosville. It was owned by Kathy Moss, Bucks County. The Reserve Champion Light Weight lamb was purchased by Lester Wagner, Pen Argyl, for \$1.35 per pound. The lamb weighed 96 pounds and was exhibited by Geoffrey Harvey, Bucks County. The Reserve Champion Medium Weight lamb, weighing 114 pounds was sold at \$2.10 per pound to Pat-Ric Farm, New Ringgold. It was owned by Andy Wagner, Northampton County.

The sale, as was the show on Friday, was conducted by the Agricultural Extension Service, with the county agents of the six counties in charge. The auctioneer was Ralph Zettlemoyer.

Average price per pound of the steers with the Grand Champion included was \$.98 per pound, without the top, the average was \$.92 per pound. Last year's averages were \$.95 and \$.91.

Average price per pound for the lambs with the Grand Champion included was \$1.22 per pound, without the top, the average was \$1.15 per pound. Last year's averages were \$1.11 per pound, without the top, the average was \$1.00 per pound.

The total sales of the 32 steers in the sale were \$34,720.70. The total sales of the 64 lambs in the sale were \$8,138.35.

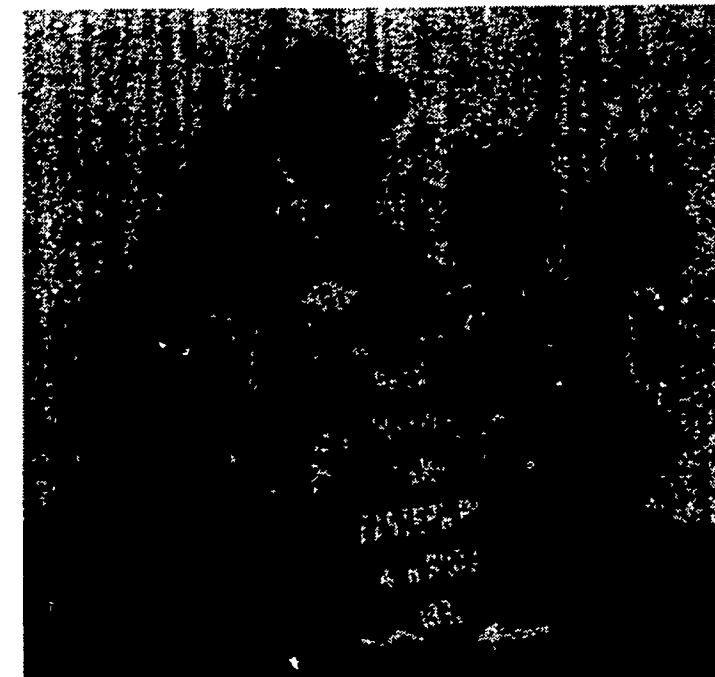
