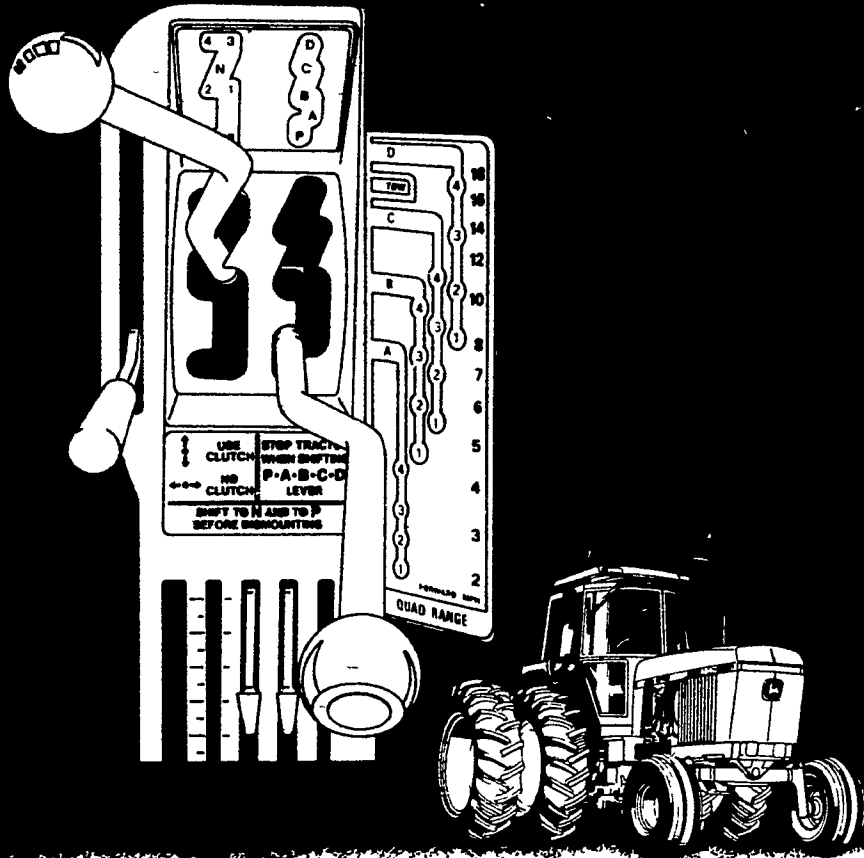

About 10 years ago, a lot of you came into our store to see a new John Deere transmission called Quad-Range

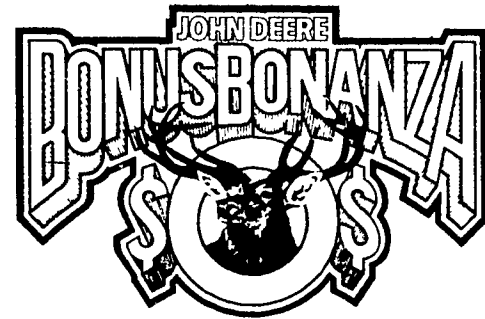

It was a two-lever transmission. You selected the working range with one and did all your speed changes with the other. A simple "Z" pattern clarified everything.

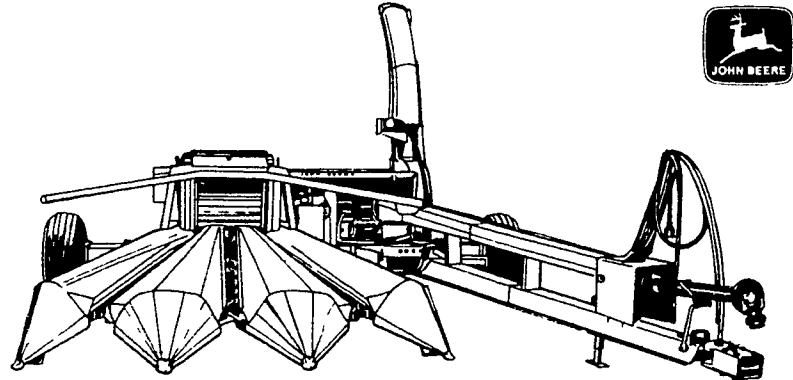
What a success! Immediately it became John Deere's largest-selling transmission. So much so that it soon became standard equipment. The only rival was another John Deere transmission called Power Shift.
