

Stahl tops Somerset Co. DHIA for milk

SOMERSET — At the completion of Somerset County DHIA 58th year, George C. Stahl, Somerset turned in the top herd average for milk. Stahl's 63 head of grade Holsteins averaged 20,903 pounds of milk.

Reimandale Farm, Berlin, finished with high butterfat production of 793 pounds. Reimandale made the record with 58 head of registered Holsteins.

William Hunsberger's 4-year-old Holstein "Glad", finished with the high individual cow record for milk. The Davidsville Dairyman's Oakleigh Electron Harmony daughter turned in a complete record of 31,591 pounds of milk.

"Victory" a 6-year-old Holstein owned by North View Farm, Berlin, finished with the top individual cow record for butterfat. The P-A Longview Big Apple daughter completed the year with 1,450 pounds of milk.

The committee makes many determinations during the year in

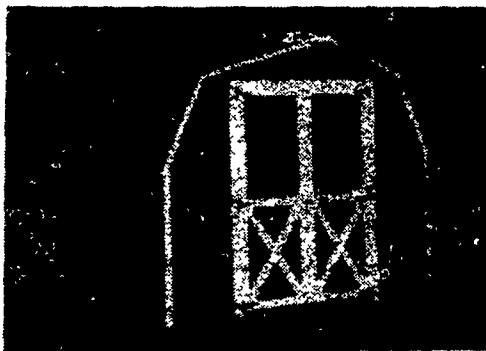
conjunction with National and State recommendations which regulate commodity price, production control, and the Agricultural Conservation Program on the local level.

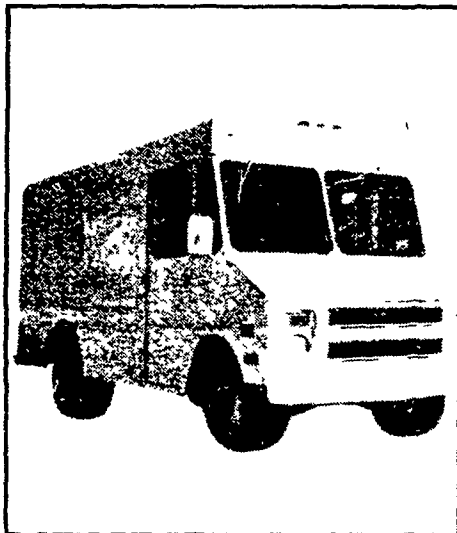
