HOLLIDAYSBURG - The Blair County DHIA recently completed its 53rd year with 95 whole-year herds on DHIA and seven Owner-Sampler herds

The 6,300 cows on test in the county turned in averages of 15,940 pounds of milk and 606 pounds of lat, averages which have more than doubled since the county's testing programs began in 1929.

Raymond Diebold of Altoona topped the county's milk production with a high average of 20,227 pounds of milk Dawn Baker of Martinsburg completed the year with the highest butterfat average at 757 pounds of fat Rodney Metzler of Martinsburg turned in the highest but-

tertat production for a single cow His 5 year-old grade Holstein finished with 1,207 pounds of fat on 24,873 pounds of milk

An 8-year-old registered Holstein, owned by Blackcrest Farms of Altoona, completed the year with the high record in milk production at 30.673 pounds of milk

Blair County 4 H'er, Brian Kelly received a plaque for his 6 year-old cow ' Iris'' who finished with 985 pounds of fat on 19,690 pounds of milk at 5 0 percent test

A 3-year-old cow owned by FFA member Kenneth Hoover topped milk proudction in FFA competition Hoover's Arlinda ' finished at 19,849 pounds of milk and 748 pounds of fat
