Trade fairly active during the week with improved demand and aggressiveness of buyers improved over previous weeks. The advance in carcass beet prices coupled with the introduction of new buying interest on the market forced the live prices to follow the upward pattern and close at higher levels. Receipts this week 2900. Compared to 2310 last week and 4546 last year.

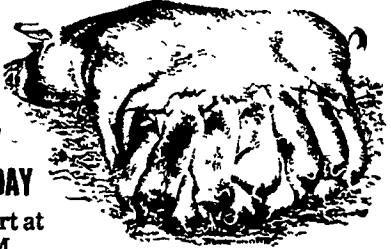

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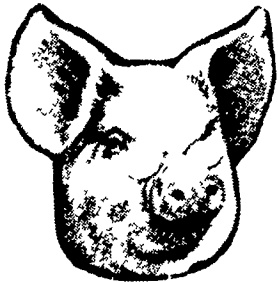
