**CARLISLE** — Cumberland County Dairy Herd Improvement records show that 7,302 cows in 117 herds were on production testing in November according to Duane C. Duncan, County Agent. Of the 99 herds on DHIA, 28 herds had an average fat production of 600 pounds. During the month 109 completed their 305 lactation with 650 lbs. of butterfat. 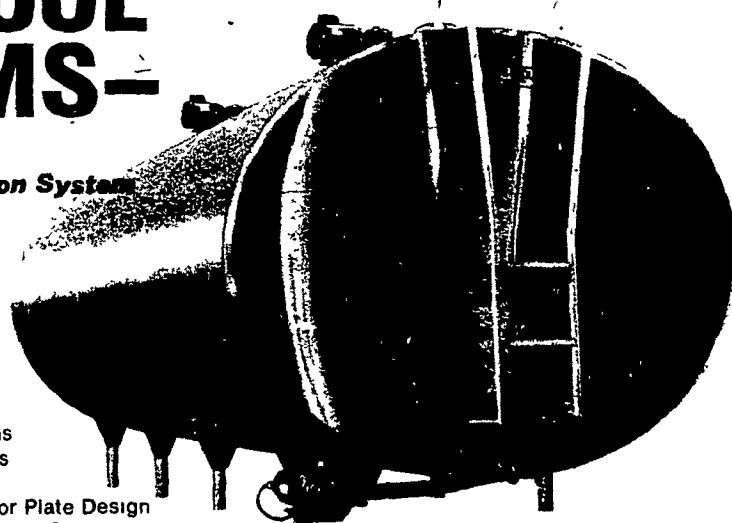

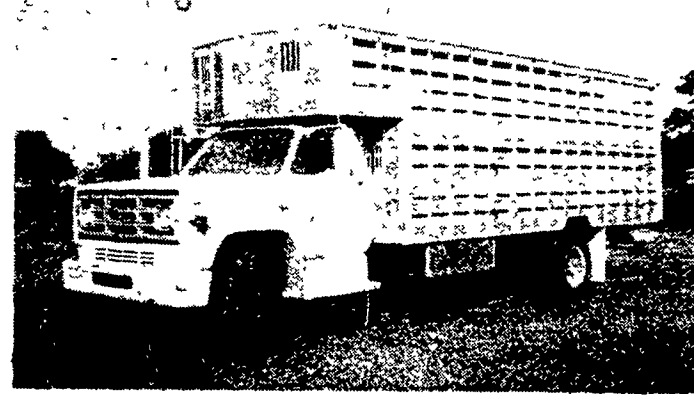
