FARM SHOW — Lancaster County was well represented during the Farm Show's poultry and egg judging.

R.W. Sauder, Inc. received two special awards in addition to several blue ribbons. The wholesale egg distributor from Lititz walked off with awards for Best Dozen White Eggs, Best Dozen Brown Eggs and Best Five Dozen Brown Eggs.

Ray Baker, Manheim collected three blue ribbons for his Bantam and game bird entries. Melvin Bollinger, Lititz scored two blues for large fowl and Asiatic breeds.
