Fix up the fields, too

WEST CHESTER -When a farmer has a hole in the roof of his barn, he usually repairs it without delay (before the framing rots out). If the gas tank leaks, it usually gets repaired sooner rather than later. If there is a gap in the fence and a valuable cow gets out, it is usually repaired before the loss of another valuable capital asset.

Top soil is another valuable asset for a farmer. When the top soil flows onto the neighbor's property, down into the creek or into the road, a landowner is losing a most valuable capital asset. When the top soil is gone, crop production falls which means less income for the farmer.
