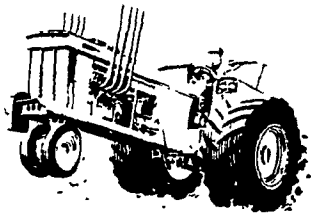

USDA surplus cheese arrives in PA

HARRISBURG — State Agriculture Secretary Penrose, Hallowell said Monday the first shipments of surplus processed American cheese from the U.S. Department of Agriculture have begun arriving at warehouses across the state.

Hallowell said the total Pennsylvania allotment of 1.6 million pounds of cheese had been ordered, and would be delivered to the Bureau of Government Donated Foods in the next few weeks.

Food inspectors from the Bureau of Foods & Chemistry, he said, are taking representative samples

of the cheese as it arrives to insure that it is unadulterated.

The Agriculture Secretary said the Department was continuing to work with hundreds of charitable, non-profit organizations in setting up a workable system for the eventual distribution of the cheese in each county. He said the three regional food banks in Erie, Philadelphia and Pittsburgh, as well as the Pennsylvania Coalition on Food and Nutrition were continuing to provide additional information on potential distribution sites across the state, and thanked them for their assistance.

Hallowell said that as soon as agreements have been signed with all participating local distributors for the cheese, information on sites, availability of cheese and times for distribution will be announced.

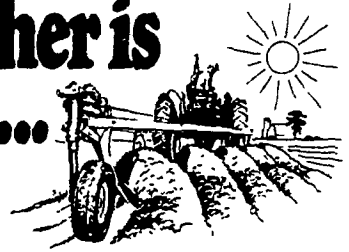
