



Reserve grand honor went to Liberty Patriot 1, the reserve senior titlist shown by Deep Down Ranch, Paluxy, Texas; Sugar Loaf Angus; and Dr. Donald E. Young, Somerset, Virginia.

White Hall Farms, North Garden. Virginia, led Keldonas Erica ET2 to the intermediate and grand champion female spots. Clifford Simmons, Williamston, Michigan, followed to reserve grand with iunior titlist Omega Queen OXO7.

White Hall Farms, McCurry Brothers of Sedgwick, Kansas, and Omega Farms of Williamston, Michigan, grouped Sir Williams Warrant offspring to win the getof-sire and junior get classes. Sugar Loaf Angus put together the best six head bred and owned or coowned by an exhibitor.

sylvania; Sarah Kyburg, Lyons, New York; and Sugar Loaf Angus. Baldridge Cracker Jack 280 took reserve for Green Country Angus, Stilwell, Oklahoma.

Ira's Happy Times collected the intermediate champion rosette for White Hall Farms, Rich Valley Cattle Co. of Marion, Virginia, and Oak Crest Livestock Inc., Carnesville, Georgia. Cedar Creek Angus, Bastrop, Texas, won reserve with R&J Cedar Point 1510.

Sugar Loaf Angus led SL Northern Chance 120K to the senior bull calf championship, and Dr. and Mrs. Ron Nida of Red Rock, Oklahoma, took reserve with B&R Black Revolution 8008. 
Bulls go 'on parade' March 20


