undue restrictions on exercise of these rights that might currently exist and thereby permit the utilization of voluntary prayer in public schools.

— H.B. 303 Income Tax-Head of Household-Personal Exemption: amend Maryland tax law to allow for an additional personal

exemption of \$800.00 for a taxpayer who files a federal return as a head of household.

Opposed Bills

— H.B. 77 Alien's Employment: if a person hires, recruits or refers for private or public employment, an alien who is not duly authorized to work by immigration laws, he is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined not more than \$500.

— H.B. 255 Retail Sales Tax - Amounts Credited to Transportation Trust Fund: would transfer portion of retail sales to Transportation Trust Fund to pay the cost of providing bicycle ways.

— H.B. 245 Transportation-Bicycle Ways-Construction: mandates Department of Transportation cannot approve a bid for highway construction or reconstruction unless it provides for the inclusion of a bicycle way on the project.

— H.B. 498 Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation - Environmental Trust Fund: give Public Service Commission authority to adjust the amount of Environmental Surcharge on electric energy to provide one and one-half million dollars to Md. Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation.

— S.B. 26 Litter Reduction, Resource Conservation and Materials Recycling: calls for creation of a new program within the Department of Natural Resources; mandates a tax bill be assessed on certain manufacturers, wholesalers and retailers; money to be used to encourage, manage and fund litter control and recycling.

— S.B. 257 Power Plant Siting: would extend duration of the environmental surcharge on electricity from 1985 to 1990; money is used to fund the Power Plant Siting Program.

— S.B. 154 Motor Vehicle Insurance-Rates: would mandate that a geographical area could not be used as a factor in determining motor vehicle insurance rates. If this bill became law it would increase our vehicle insurance rates in rural areas.

— H.B. 172 Unemployment Insurance-Labor Dispute: would mandate that an individual may not be disqualified from unemployment benefits if the individual is involved in an authorized strike that has continued for more than 7 weeks.

— S.B. 401 Cruelty to Animals: amends section of the cruelty to animals law that deals with normal veterinary and agricultural husbandry practices.

— H.B. 533 Vehicle Laws - Stop Laws: would require every motor vehicle registered in this state and sold as a new vehicle after June 30, 1983, to be equipped with at least 4 stop lamps, including two mounted inside the vehicle at the base of the rear window.

— S.B. 34 Motor Vehicle Emissions Inspection: would repeal the provisions of law relating to establishment of a motor vehicle emissions inspection program in Maryland.

— H.B. 319 University of Maryland - School of Veterinary Medicine: bill calls for establishment of a School of Veterinary Medicine at University of Maryland.
