



Deadline nears for Delaware dairy tour of Europe


NEWARK, Del. — It's time to sign up for third annual Delaware Dairy and Farm Tour of Europe this August. Europeanborn University of Delaware extension dairy specialist George Haenlein will lead a group around the Netherlands (Holland) and Belgium, culminating in a boat trip down the Rhine River into Germany.

Since much of Holland is below sea level, the Dutch use engineering and ingenuity to hold back the sea. Those on the tour will see farming on polders—land that was once under water. The group will visity dairy, vegetable, and flower farms. They'll also see cheese-making at the famous Dutch towns of Edam and Gouda, and view the traditional Dutch method of generating power, the windmill.

Tour members can glide along the canals of Amsterdam, view the Rembrandt treasures of the Rijksmuseum, see china-making at Delft and lace-making at Bruges. Along the way they'll visit castles, a diamond factory, and recreation of Holland in miniature at Madurodam.

In short, they'll see all the regular tourist highlights of these charming countries, and also get an intensive look at some of the specialized problems of agriculture, including ground water purity and soil erosion.
