

## Day salutes farmers

three Goodyear blimps to parades and shopping-mall displays.

Secretary of Agriculture John R. Block is scheduled to speak in Washington at a special Ag Day luncheon, followed by a reception on Capitol Hill.

But most farmers and consumers will have to turn to the local level to celebrate in the proclaimed glitter and glamour of Ag Day. They may not see the Goodyear Blimp and they may not get the day off, but they can take part by visiting a nearby school where Agri-Women, teachers and Ag-promotion groups plan special educational programs.

Or they could watch a television special on farm exports — how they are created and their impact on the economy. Titled "Prosperity in the Balance," the half-hour documentary was shot on location in Germany, China,

Korea, and Europe, and will be hosted by veteran-actor Rex Allen.

Highlights of the program include a segment on how the American Soybean Association sold German consumers on the benefits of cooking with soy oil through a promotion program that included work with processors and

a communications program targeted at editors and consumers. As a result of the program, soybean oil consumption increased 50 percent, creating an expanded market for U.S. soybeans. Check local television guides for airing times and channels.

Serving as chairman for this

year's Ag Day is Secretary Block on the national level while Penrose Hallowell, state Ag Secretary, will be overseeing the festivities here in Pennsylvania.

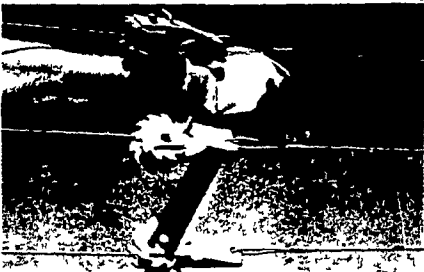
