Majority receipts Medium Frame 1 and Mixed 1-2 400-800 lbs. feeder steers and heifers. Best demand noted on thin fleshed cattle suitable for grazing with these holding up best.

SLAUGHTER COWS: 1.00-1.50 higher. Late sales Utility and Commercial 2-3 40.25-43.10; low dressing and YG 3-4 39.00-41.50; Canner and Cutters in limited

supply late. Slaughter bulls in small supply steady to 1.00 lower with YG 1 1300-1700 lbs. 50.00-54.00. Salable receipts this week near 31,200 head compared with 22,597 last week and 21,851 last year. Feeder cattle and calves made up 95 percent of supply with large percentage arriving off wheat pastures; cows and bulls made up 5 percent of supply.

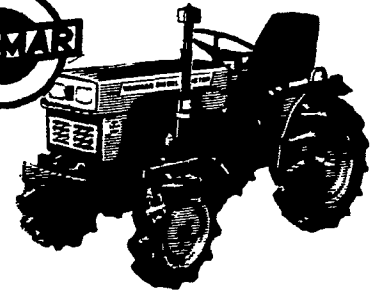

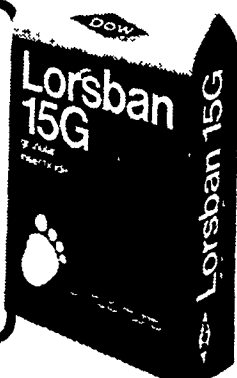
