lifetime producer for Walnut Lane Masine who had 11 lactations totaling 139,288 pounds of milk and 6,753 pounds of fat.

The only honor to escape the Stuffs went to Ray Garber, Guerndale Farm, Chambersburg. Garber had the highest producing Guernsey in the county. She is Guerndale Telestar Magnolia who made 17,346 pounds of milk and 764 pounds of fat in 305




