ASA, NFU discuss farm problems

WASHINGTON, D.C. Association and — Leaders of two National Farmers national farm groups — Union — met last week the American Soybean to discuss ways they

could work together to increase farm profits.

"We agreed on several issues," says Charles Hamon, a Valley Falls, Kansas, farmer and ASA president. "Both of us are concerned about high interest rates and low prices. Both oppose current cargo preference and user fee legislation. Both feel we must improve the U.S. transportation system."

The two groups also discussed the state soybean checkoff programs which support soybean research and worldwide export promotion programs.
