glut, D.I. instituted a program to encourage less production. The program, aptly named, HELP, began March 1 and will be applied through June. HELP provides an incentive for dairy farmers to maintain production more nearly in line with their base, Strock explained.

For D.I. shippers in Federal Order 4, the program will offer no change in the method of establishing base since they have already been operating under a base plan.

Federal Order 2 producers who have not operated under a base plan will have a daily base established at a level equal to their average daily production for February 1982.

Each division of D.I. will receive the appropriate amount of money based on the new system. Local divisions have the flexibility to determine how funds will be distributed within the division, but

may not pay more than \$10.50 for milk in excess of base.

Inter-State, not yet walking the surplus tightrope, has kept all its milk within the Mid-Atlantic marketing area.

"We've been able to handle all the milk we've had so far," said IMPCO spokesperson Kathy Gill.

She noted that the co-op's manufacturing plant, Holly, has been operating seven days a week and last month processed 37 million pounds.

According to Gill, IMPCO is operating at about the same level as last year as far as surplus is concerned.

"Barring any major close-downs," Gill remarked, "we're pretty well set to get through the Spring Flush."

In making several attempts to get the haulers' side of the story, Lancaster Farming's telephone calls rang in empty houses. It seems the haulers have been quite busy, lately.

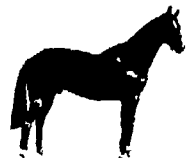
