### Franklin offers no-till seeder

CHAMBERSBURG — "About 10 years ago, no-till corn planting was getting started in Franklin County and now no-till grain and hay seeding is getting started. We hope that no-till grain drills will become as popular and well used as no-till corn planters," reports John R. Akers, district conservationist with the Chambersburg office of the USDA Soil Conservation Service.

Many of the same guidelines apply for using a no-till grain drill as for using a no-till corn planter, such as planting in a crop residue, Akers comments. Proper tuning in using pesticides is important to control weeds and insects, he adds.

"Grain and hay crops

are more sensitive to herbicide residues left after corn has been planted," he cautions. "You really need to plan about two years ahead and apply the appropriate herbicides in the corn if you will be following up with a no-till grain or hay seeding. If lime is needed, this should be applied the previous year to the no-till grain or hay seeding since lime may activate unused herbicides."

Anyone interested in trying some no-till grain or hay seeding this spring without buying a no-till grain drill should contact the Franklin County Conservation District for information about renting one. The District is located at 550 Cleveland Avenue, Chambersburg, telephone 717-264-8074.
