A good demand by most interests held prices at steady levels through Monday and Tuesday, in spite of a 29 pct. increase in salable numbers compared to a week ago. Although the dressed beef trade depreciated at midweek, buyers were forced to compete aggressively for the reduced Wednesday offerings, pushing the market higher for the week. Overall finish for the session fair on steers, but just ordinary on heifers. Steers made up 40 pct of 4 day receipts, heifers 29 pct., cows 9 pct., feeders 19 pct.

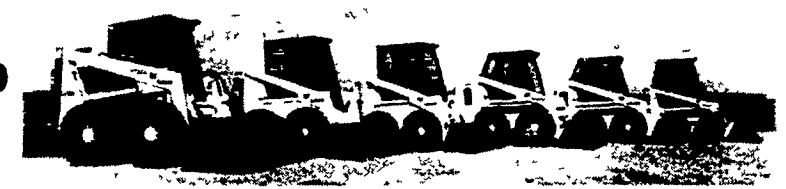
