Report supplied by USDA

Compared to Tuesday's 4:00 report: Steer and heifer beef steady to 1.00 lower. Demand and trading light to moderate. Supplies moderate to heavy. Processors maintaining a bearish attitude in face of increased cattle slaughter levels this week. Packers reluctant to sell at lower prices due to high live cattle replacement costs.

The boxed beef carcass cutout value declined \$.49 to an estimated \$116.53 per cwt.

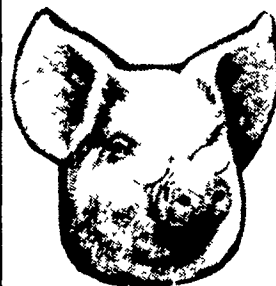
