Fed cattle prices moved higher for the fifth consecutive week, as

buyer demand continued strong and the dressed beef trade advanced. A large share of the upturn came on Wednesday's light run, when buyers were forced to purchase cattle for immediate slaughter needs. Cattle feeders continue to market cattle on a current basis, as indicated by the nature of the salable receipts.

Steers made up 46 pct. of the weeks receipts, heifers 35 pct., cows 8 pct., feeders 10 pct. four day receipts 11527; last week 11420; year ago 12277.

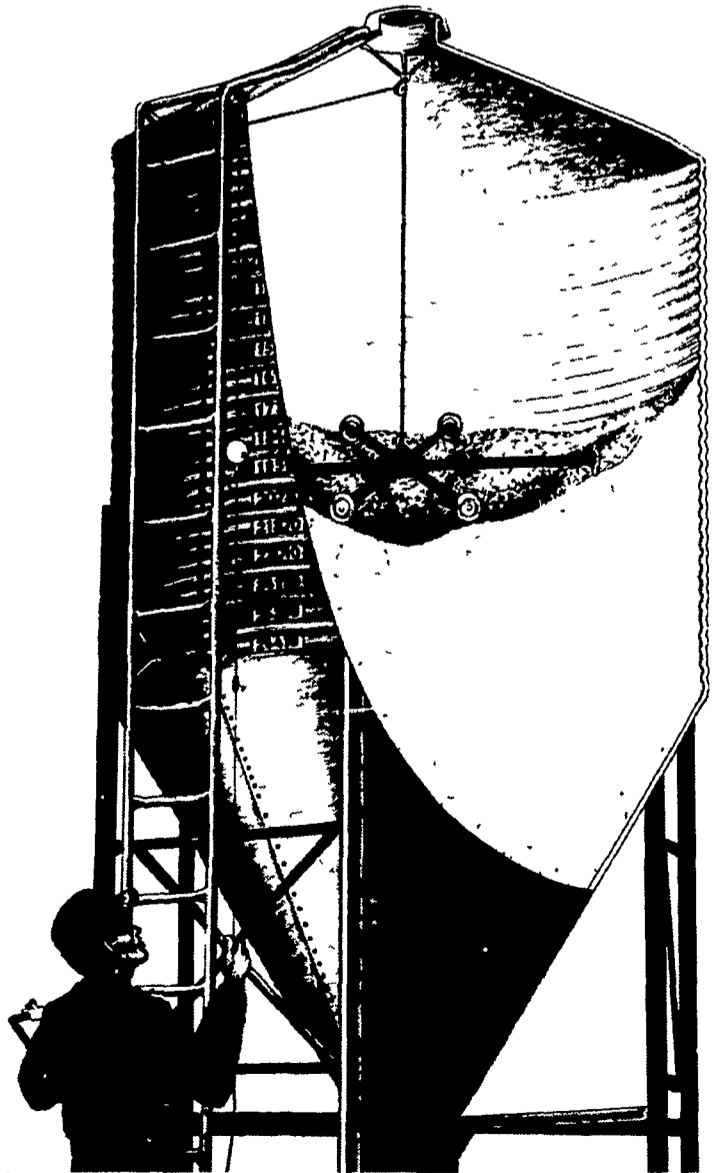
