

Egg futures includes nest run eggs

DECATUR, Ga. — The Chicago Mercantile Exchange has notified the United Egg Producers that the new egg futures contract includes nest run eggs deliverable at par and will start floor trading on May 19. Deliveries will begin in September.

This contract was approved by the Commodity Futures Trading Commission on April 21, and sanctioned by the CME Board of Governors on May 5.

"This follows nearly 2½ years of effort by UEP, CME, USDA and many devoted egg industry

representatives in revitalizing the egg futures contract," announced Al Pope, UEP president.

A spokesman for the CME indicated that the new egg futures contract offers par quality for nest run eggs at 88 percent AA and A for loads (150 cases), and 75 percent AA and A for individual cases. Dirties, as determined by one-half inch or greater of stains, adhering dirt or foreign material, shall not exceed 5 percent.

USDA verified in an egg industry survey that the percentage restrictions on the dirties were

acceptable and reasonable. The contract further restricts checks at less than 5 percent and loss at 2 percent. In addition, the par weight specifications limits the average of the unit between 48 to 50 pounds net, with no individual case less than 46 nor more than 51 pounds net.

The spokesman hastened to add that the tight range assured buyers of high quality eggs insuring the success of this new contract through active trading.

Check ponds for bass reproduction

UNIVERSITY PARK — One key to successful bass-bluegill management in ponds is bass reproduction according to Terry D. Rader, associate professor of forest resources Extension at Penn State.

Largemouth bass are the primary sport fish in most ponds and they also are necessary to keep bluegill numbers under control. "As long as bass reproduction is successful, the fish populations of bass-bluegill ponds may be considered to be in a reasonable condition," says Rader.

This is the time of year when bass spawning occurs. When water temperatures reach 68 degrees F, spawning activity begins. Look for bass and bass nests in water two to three feet deep. After the eggs hatch, schools of bass fry (newly hatched bass) will remain near the nest for a time. These schools of bass fry are guarded by the male. After the schools of bass fry scatter, they may be found along the margin of the pond during the remainder of the year.

"Young largemouth bass develop a black stripe running lengthwise along their sides," says Rader. It is relatively easy to distinguish the young largemouth bass from other small fishes because of the black stripe. Walk slowly and quietly around the edge of the pond to observe the fishes in the shallow water. This kind of observation may be all that is needed to detect

the presence of young largemouth bass.

If inspection of your pond fails to reveal any young largemouth bass and if the bluegills appear to be too numerous and stunted, it may be an indication

that extensive remedial management is necessary. Contact your county agent for advice on restoring an acceptable balance to the bass bluegill populations in your pond.
