Soil erosion by water moves slowly. Anyone with a soil erosion problem that would like assistance with it can contact the local U.S. Soil Conservation Service

To avoid erosion, the soil must be protected from moving water. Dense vegetation, cover crops, mulches, grasses, or trees will intercept rain and slow down runoff.

Where tillage leaves the soil exposed, barriers like terraces or sown strips of different crops can help control runoff. Otherwise, tillage needs to be confined to nearly level soils where water

moves slowly. Anyone with a soil erosion problem that would like assistance with it can contact the local U.S. Soil Conservation Service
