A 3.00-4.00 decline in the dressed beef trade precipitated one of the sharpest weekly downturns in recent sessions Weight has a primary factor in the bidding, with steers under 1050 lbs. and heifers under 925 lbs. subjected to severe discounts in many cases. Overall finish again just ordinary, as many

offerings appear to have had less than a normal feeding period. Lower prices in C.M.E. trading also contributed to the bearish atmosphere of the trade

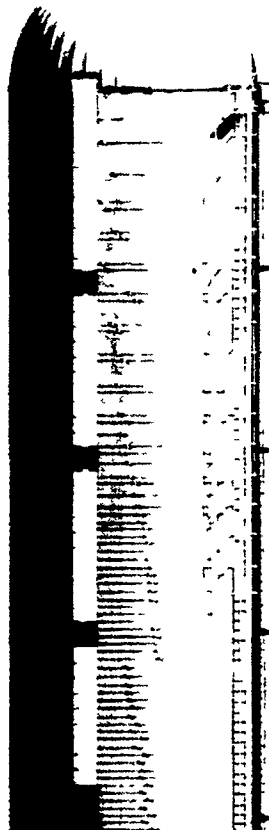

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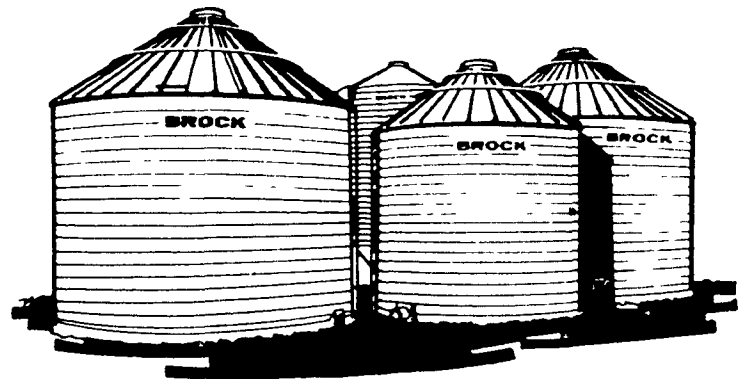
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
