Fed cattle prices trended lower for the third consecutive week, following the lead of a 2.00-3.00 break in the dressed beef trade. Sharp early declines were partially recouped by midweek as salable numbers remained modest and buyers were forced to replenish depleted inventories. Some recovery in the beef trade also noted at midweek. Overall finish remained consistent with recent sessions, with many "short feds" offerings apparent in the consist. Consequently, heavier choice steers and heifers enjoyed the best of a selective and cautious trade


