VANILLA PUDDING CAKE

Beat 4 egg yolks. Add 9 T. water and beat well. Add 3/4 c sugar and beat. Sift 2 cups flour and 3 t baking powder.

Add to first mixture. Beat 4 eggs whites and 1 t. salt. Fold into batter.

Pour into long cake pan lined with wax paper. Bake at 325 degrees for 10 minutes then put crumbs on top

3/4 c. brown sugar

1/2 c. flour

2 T. butter

Bake till done about 30 minutes

Cool, cut in half and fill with the following pudding:

Cook. 3 c. milk

1 heaping T. flour

1 heaping T. cornstarch

2 eggs

1 t vanilla

Cool thoroughly before filling cake.

1 lb. graham crackers

2 3/4-oz boxes instant vanilla pudding

3 c milk

1 pt heavy cream

Line bottom of 13x9x2 inch dish with whole grahams Beat pudding mix and milk until smooth. Whip cream and fold in pudding. Spread half of it over grahams. Place another layer of whole grahams on top. Top with remaining pudding. Cover with third layer of whole grahams Spread chocolate topping on top

Topping:

1/2 c. chocolate chips

3 T butter

3 T. milk

1 t vanilla

2 t. corn syrup

1 1/2 c. 10X sugar

Melt chocolate chips and butter Beat in remaining ingredients until smooth. Spread on top layer of grahams. Chill 24 hours before serving.

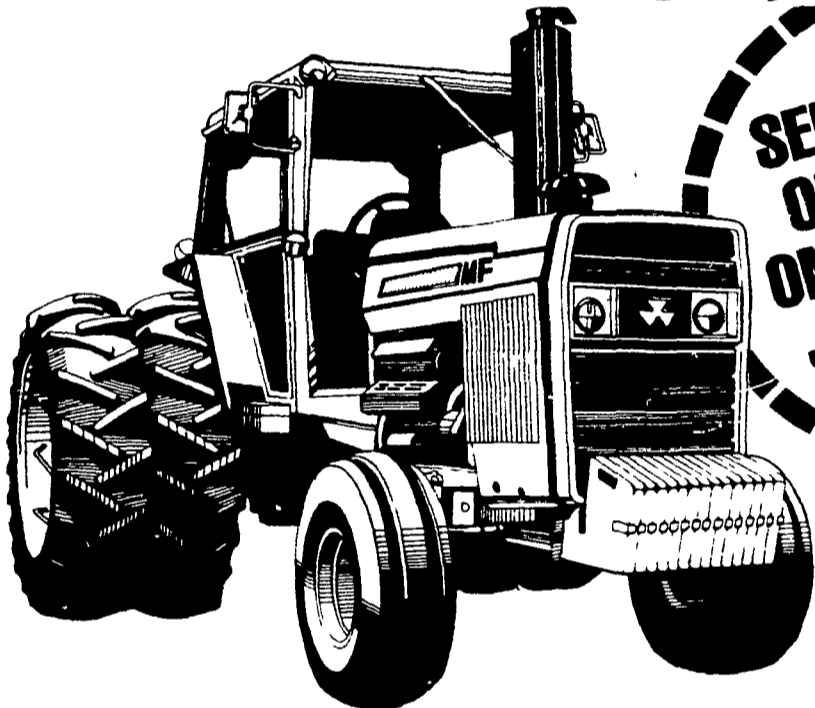

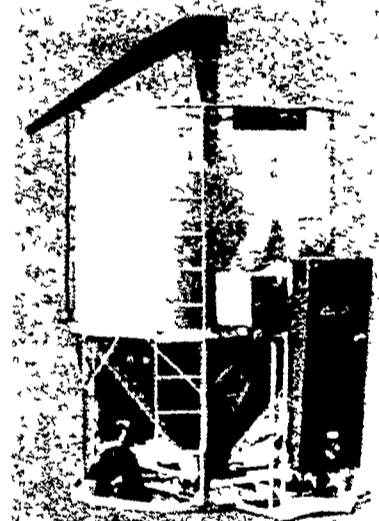
