Choice 4 steer and heifer steady to 1.00 lower. Good and Steer and Heifer not established. Demand and trading light to moderate, supplies more than ample for demand. The boxed beef carcass cutout value declined .44 to an estimated 105.90 per cwt. Sales reported on 82 loads of steer and heifer beef.
