

# Yorkshire bred gilt claims championship, commands top bid

LEBANON — More than 50 head of registered Yorkshires were consigned to this year's Pennsylvania Yorkshire Co-op Association Summer Show and Sale, held last week at the Lebanon Area Fairgrounds.

Judging the show was Henry Gruber of A&B Packing, Allentown. Champion bred gilt of the show was farrowed September 1981 and shown as a junior gilt by Leon Arnold, Lebanon. This champion, LLA 1 F Sandra 54-10,

was sired by HOE9 Future 63-6 and also was the top-selling gilt of the evening sale, bringing \$600.

Reserve champion bred gilt was CLL1 Choice 124 consigned by Calvin Lazarus and Sons, Whitehall.

Champion boar honors were awarded to a January entry, named JES2 Champion 7-7, consigned by Strawbridge and McCleary, Stewartstown. This boar brought \$675 during the evening sale.

Strawbridge and McCleary also had the champion open gilt and

champion littermate pairs. Reserve champion boar went to Calvin Lazarus while reserve champion open gilt was awarded to Thomas Arnold, Lebanon. Leon Arnold also consigned the reserve champion littermate pairs.

Averages for the sale included \$402 for 21 bred gilts, \$431 for ten boars, and \$260 for the open gilts sold. A total of 22 open gilts were sold.

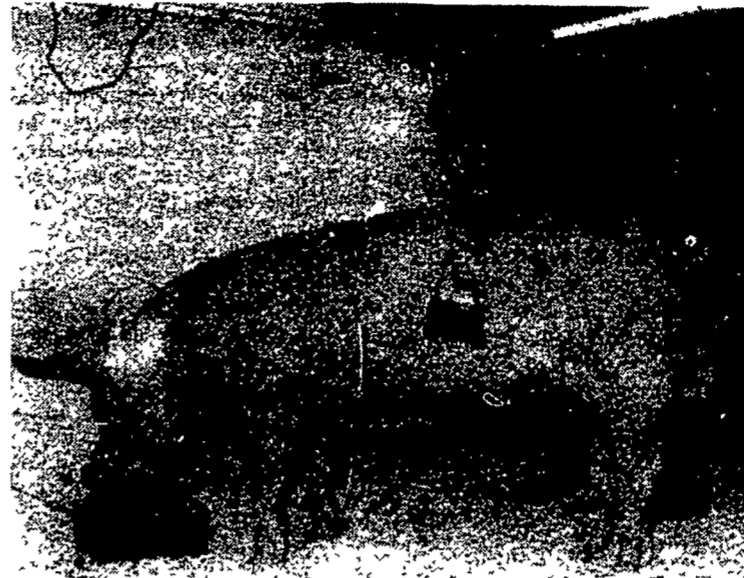

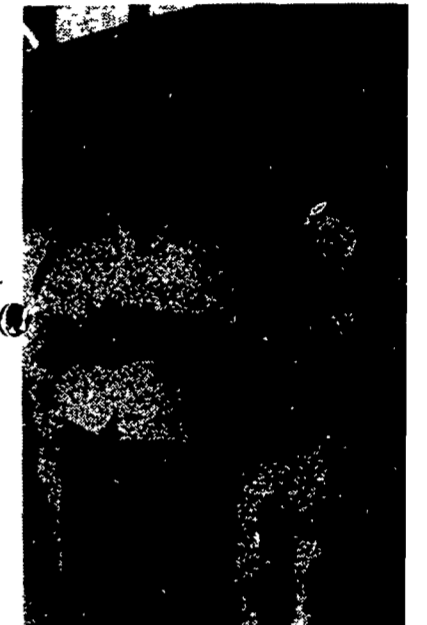

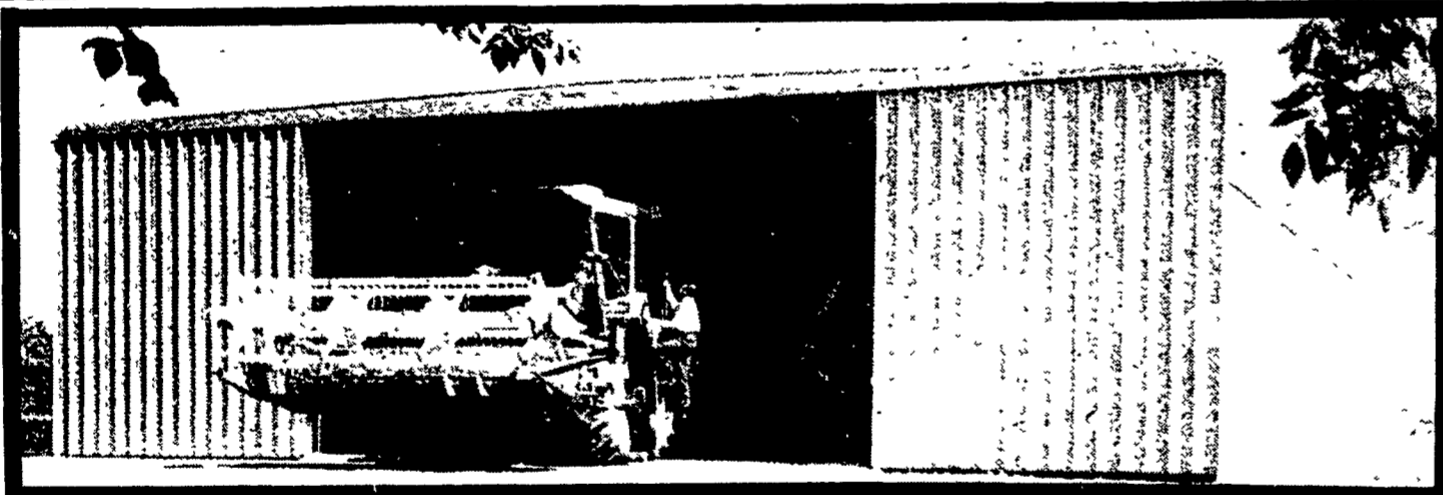
