### WASHINGTON MONUMENT

6 flavors of ice cream  
chocolate syrup  
raspberry syrup  
nuts in syrup  
bananas  
whipped cream  
candy decorettes, blue and red  
whole cherries

Into a very tall glass put 1/2 oz. chocolate syrup and 1 large scoop of vanilla ice cream. Add raspberry syrup and 2 or 3 slices of banana. Then continue by alternating with syrups, nuts, and ice cream of different flavors, using a total of 6 dippers of ice cream. Place a half banana upright in center on top, forming the height, and cover with plenty of whipped cream. Sprinkle with red and blue candy decorettes and 5 whole cherries around the top edge of glass. Insert small American flags.

1/2 c. whipping cream  
1 t. orange extract

In 1-quart saucepan melt butter with cinnamon. Remove from heat. Blend in honey and salt. Stir in whipping cream until smooth. Add orange extract. Serve warm.

### PUMPKIN ICE CREAM PIE

9-inch baked pie shell, chilled  
1 qt. vanilla ice cream, softened  
1 c. canned pumpkin  
3/4 c. sugar  
3/4 t. pumpkin pie spice  
1/4 t. salt  
1 c. whipping cream, whipped  
1/2 c. chopped salted peanuts

Spoon ice cream into pie shell; freeze. Combine pumpkin, sugar, pie spice and salt; mix well. Fold in whipped cream. Spoon over ice cream layer; sprinkle with peanuts. Cover. Freeze several hours or overnight.

### PEANUT FUDGE RIPPLE ICE CREAM

3 eggs  
1 3/4 c. sugar  
3 c. milk

### HONEY BUTTER SAUCE

1/2 c. butter  
1/8 t. cinnamon  
3/4 c. honey

3/4 c. chopped salted peanuts  
1 c. fudge topping

Beat eggs until foamy in a large mixing bowl. Gradually add sugar; beat until thickend. Add milk, cream, and vanilla; mix thoroughly. Stir in peanuts. Chill. Churn-freeze. After freezing transfer ice cream to plastic freezer container, alternating layers of ice cream with cooled fudge topping; swirl each layer with spatula for marbled effect.

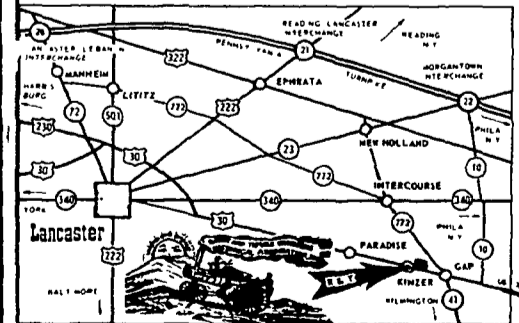
