Grand Champion Holstein for the Youth Show Day was Fack-herd Elevation Brassy bred by Richard and Marilyn Fackard of East Troy, and owned and shown by 11-year-old Terri Fackard. The Fackards carried off blue ribbons in many classes in the Holstein judging on Friday and ended up Fremier Breeder and Exhibitor with Richard and Georgia Jenkins of Troy running a close second.


