Old Habits

Old habits are hard to break and one of the oldest is producing more milk than last year. At least it seems that way in Order 2 where in April of this year, for the first time since August 1978 you produced less milk than the same month of the previous year.

At that time - four years ago it lasted only one month and you were back to increasing production. This year, it was the same story with May milk shipments up nine million pounds over last year and June up 14 million pounds.

However, even though you're back on the track of increasing production, it isn't as heavy as it was a year ago. The first six months in Order 2 this year, shipments increased about 70 million pounds or 1.2 percent higher than 1981.

That's a lot less than the 198 you jumped in the first six months of 1981 compared to 1980.

No doubt the pace is slackening but you still haven't turned the corner.

you did it on price last month. May gained two cents on the exchange.

was the low for for the season in Order 2 at \$12.61 and June milk was up to \$12.63.
