
Beiler Sweeps Union Co. Holstein Show

MIFFLINBURG - Kenneth Beiler of Mifflinburg captured the Grand Champion title of the Open, the FFA and the 4-H shows at the Union County Fair, recently.

Beiler's 5-year-old Parkmont A Citation Banner was purchased at the Ag Arena Sale in December and earned top honors in the Open and 4-H shows. The A Citation Sovereign daughter is projected at almost 17,000 pounds of milk and 750 pounds of fat. She currently has a 4.6 butterfat test to her credit.

Grand Champion of the FFA show was Beiler's Clar-Dot Lindy Spice. This 2-year-old is the daughter of Mowry-C Cheif Lindy.

Reserve Champion Holstein honors went to Clarence Beiler with his Clar-Dot Milestone Sylvia, a 2-year-old daughter of Foverty-Hollow Milestone.

In 4-H competition, JoAnn Beiler éarned Reserve Champion with her 3-year-old, Clar-Dot Rumler

Ann, daughter of Whitelyn Bootmaker Rumler.

Union Co. livestock sale sets record

MIFFLINBURG — The highest selling market hog in the history of the Union County West End Fair Junior Livestock Sale, helped to push this year's sale total \$2,700 above previous records. Central Pennsylvania businesses paid over \$12,900 for the animals exhibited by Union County youth to make the fourth annual sale a huge success.

The champion showman, Rodney Walter of R1 Lewisburg, led his 1982 Grand Champion Market Hog into the sale ring on

Friday, August 6. The Mifflinburg Livestock Auction for \$387.75. FFA member's pig was selected the grand champion of the show by Richard Smith on the previous Tuesday. After fierce bidding, the 238-pound Grand Champion Market Hog was sold to Hatfield Buying Station of Danville, Fa. for \$5 a pound, at \$1,190.

The Reserve Champion Market Hog was owned by Lori Hess of R1 Millmont. The 235-pound crossbred hog was auctioned off by Lori's father Wayne Hess to Dewart

David Cotner of Lewisburg exhibited the Grand Champion Market Steer. This 1,015 pound black Angus steer was also the Champion 4-H steer. The steer was purchased by N.S. Troutman &. Sons, wholesale Beef of Freeburg, Fa. for \$1.025.15.

The Reserve Champion Steer was owned by Jeff Styers of R1 Mifflinburg. The 955-pound Hereford was selected as the champion steer of the FFA Show. The steer was purchased by Gessner Meats of Lewisburg, Fa. for **\$**773.55.

The Champion and Reserve Champion Market lambs were owned by Barb Davis of R2 Millmont. Barb's-91-pound Grand Champion Lamb was purchased by the Lewisburg Office of the Farm Credit Service for \$204.75. Clifford Valentine, branch manager of the Lewisburg office, purchased the Champion lamb for \$2.25 a pound. Barb's Reserve Champion lamb was purchased by the Mifflinburg
