

NAILE premium book available

LOUISVILLE, Ky. — Officials of the North American International Livestock Exposition announced premium catalogs for the 1982 Exposition are now available. The catalogs, which are free, contain important information pertaining to every livestock category to compete in the Exposition.

The two-week (Nov. 6-19) Expo will feature show and sale events for forty breeds of livestock in five species: dairy cattle, beef, sheep, market swine, and quarter horses.

According to a NAILE spokesman, the 9th annual North American International promises to be the largest in the history of

the Exposition, with total premiums and awards expected to stop \$300,000. The show, sponsored by the Commonwealth of Kentucky Department of Agriculture, will return to the familiar Kentucky Fair and Exposition Center in Louisville.

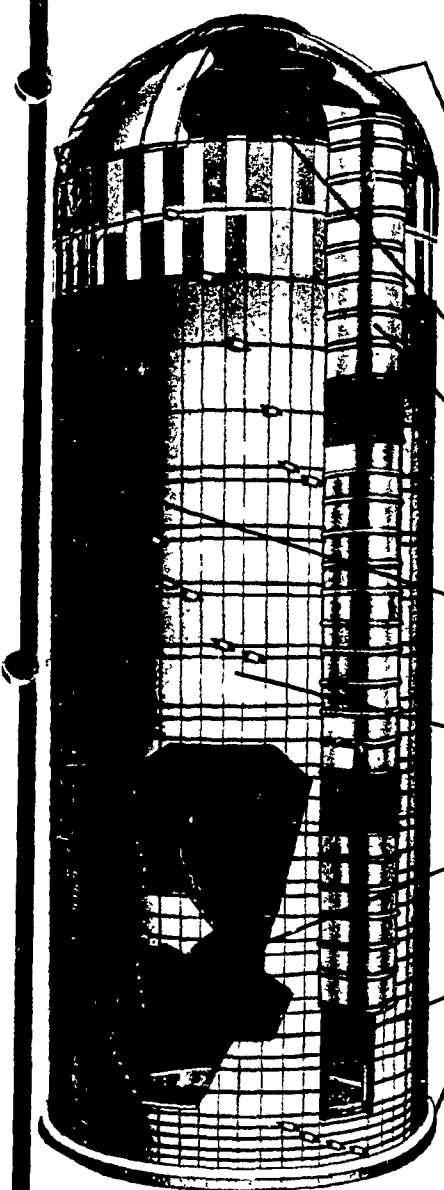

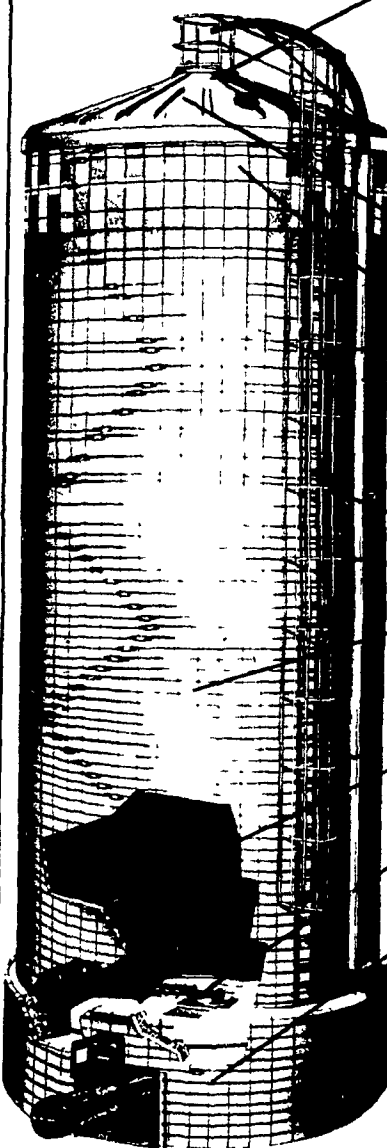

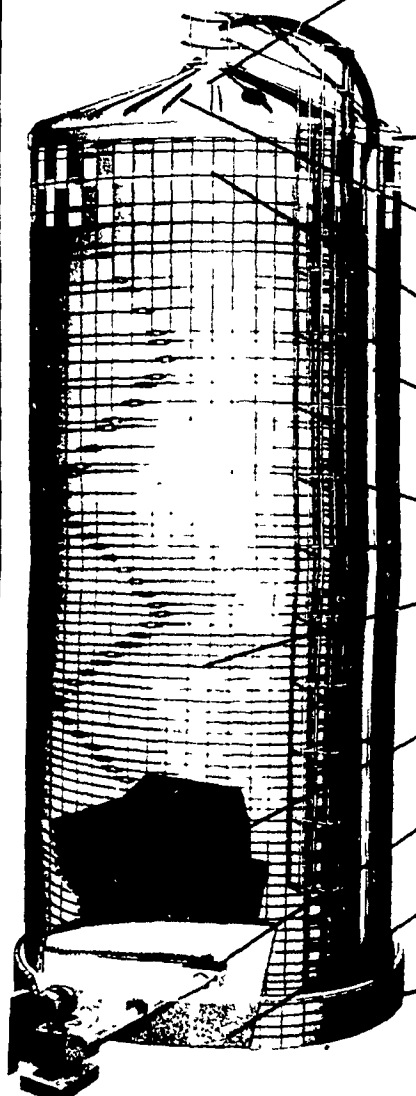
