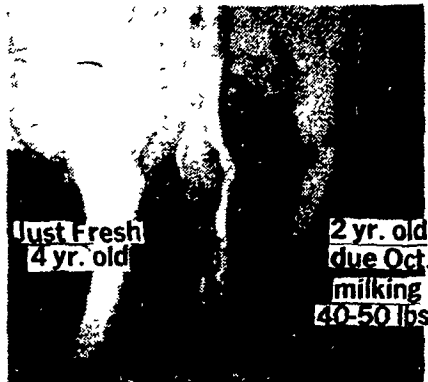


Holstein Dispersal Out of New England Consigned by Johnny Jr.

Average age from 2 yrs. to 4 yrs. old with a few older cows. They are a good working herd of cows. Cows that have milked 60-70 lbs. with their 1st lactation. 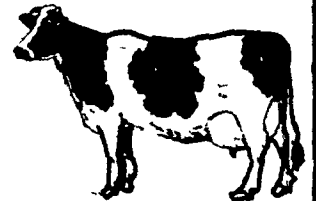
