A declining dressed beef market, which began late the previous week was a major factor for the declines this week. Overall finish, especially on heifers, continues to improve. Most buyers continue to discount heifers under 950 lbs. and steers under 1050 lbs. buyers of "two-way" cattle rather quiet this week. '

Steers made up 52 pct of the week's receipts; heifers 33 pct; cows 9 pct; feeders 4 pct. Four day receipts 8603 compared to 9853 last week and 11,642 last year.
