The majority or 89 percent of the supplies consisted of feeder cattle and calves; cows and bulls numbered near 3,000 head and made up 11 percent of the total.

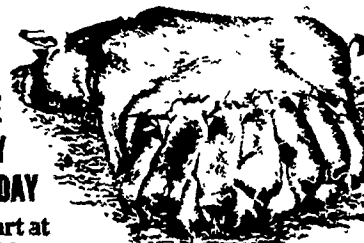
