according to USDA's Larry Marton, and the governor of each state is being invited to sign this intent to teach agriculture background.

In welcoming the delegates from several states to Harrisburg, Pennsylvania Secretary of Agriculture Penrose Hallowell echoed Block's philosophy, and added that the public needs to be aware that its high standard of living is a direct result of the efficiency of American agriculture.
