The 46-acre farm with a brick house located ½ block from the Blue Marsh dam on State Hill Road was sold for \$85,000.

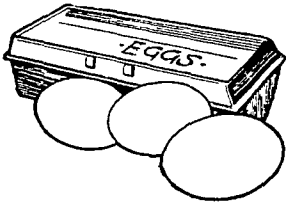

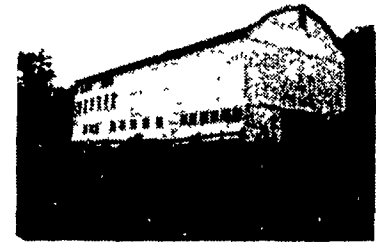
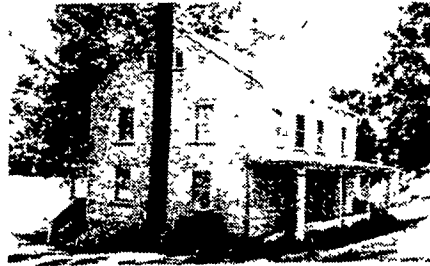
