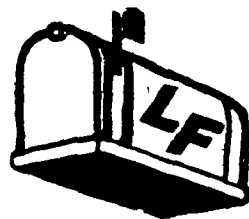

In the lightweight market lamb runoff, Michelle Bankert was first and third, second place went to Allan Crisamore, while Lori Weaver placed fourth.

and reserve overall winners in the heavyweight class were James Caudill in third, Tim Flory, fourth, Lori Weaver, fifth, and Tim Flory, sixth. Named master showman of the FFA sheep show was Red Lion chapter's Tim Flory.

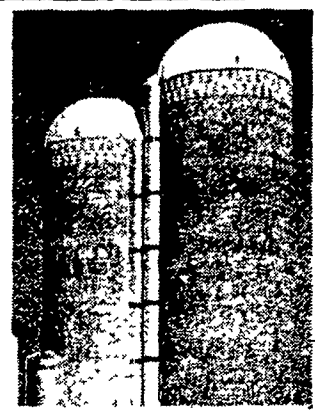
