NEWARK, DEL. — Cathy Wapniarek, a Newark, Delaware girl is one of nine 4-H members from across the nation awarded Quarter horse weanlings by Ohio sausage-maker Bob Evans.

Cathy Wapniarek was taken by surprise when she and her family received an invitation to spend a western-style roundup weekend at the Bob Evans farm in Ohio. They brought along a horse trailer, and came home with a frisky filly, Sam's Nifty Pep.

Although Cathy has taken riding lessons and participated in the 4-H horse project, she has never owned a horse. Fortunately her father, John Wapniarek, had just built a barn to house his other daughter's 4-H sheep project.

Animal lovers all, the Wapniareks also raise dogs, cats, rabbits, bees, and pigeons. The rabbits and bees are also Cathy's 4-H projects. The pigeons belong to

her younger brother, who is not yet old enough for 4-H.

The Wapniareks don't actually live on a farm, although their home stands on a large wooded lot adjoining Cathy's grandmother's farmland. John Wapniarek's current building project is a corral for Nifty. Once it's finished, Cathy will teach her how to lunge (walk around in a large circle led by a

rope).

After Nifty's fully trained, Cathy hopes to show her at the Delaware State Fair.

Cathy was awarded the horse on the basis of her 4-H and community activities. She is secretary of the Bear 4-H Club and a member of 4-H junior council. She has also participated in athletics and musical activities at school.

Red Rose Alliance plans 3 events

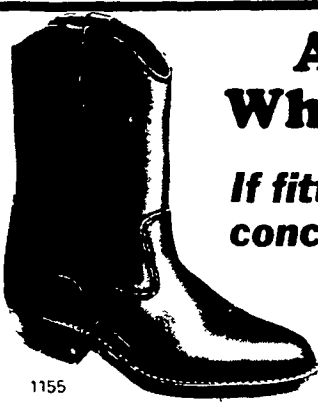
