POTATO PANCAKES

1 c. mashed potatoes
2 c. sifted enriched flour
1 t. salt
3 t. baking powder
2 eggs, beaten
1 c. milk
1 c. light corn syrup
1 t. nutmeg

Combine potatoes, sifted flour, salt, and baking powder.

Mix together the eggs and milk and stir lightly into the potato-flour mixture. Add corn syrup and nutmeg and beat well.

Bake on a greased griddle until cakes are brown on both sides. Makes 12.

OVEN PANCAKES

3 T. butter
3 eggs
1/2 c. flour
1/4 t. salt
1/2 c. milk
powdered sugar
maple syrup

Heat oven to 450 degrees.

Put butter in skillet and melt over low heat. Beat eggs well, add flour and salt. Beat until very smooth. Stir in milk and melted butter with spoon. Pour batter into skillet used to melt butter. Bake for 15 minutes at 450 degrees. Then lower oven temperature to 350 degrees and bake additional 5 to 10 minutes.

Sift powdered sugar over finished pancake. Serve with syrup.

Grange craft exhibits open to the public

HARRISBURG — Needlework, stuffed toys and other crafts made by the women of the Pennsylvania State Grange will be on display to the public during the Grange's 110th annual convention, Oct. 26 and 27, at the Scottish Rite Cathedral, 2701 N. Third St., Harrisburg.

About 100 crafts, representing top winners in county divisions of the Grange, will be judged at state finals during the Grange convention, according to Jeanette Tewksbury, state women's activities director for the Grange. State winners will be chosen in six categories: knitting and crocheting, embroidered crafts, stuffed toys, macrame, rug braiding, and baking. First place winners in knitting, embroidery and stuffed toy categories will

advance to national judging at the November convention of the National Grange in Rhode Island.

Entries in the stuffed toy contest will be donated to hospitals in nine regions of the state.

Exhibit hours will be 8:30 a.m. - 8:30 p.m. on Tuesday, Oct. 26 and Wednesday, Oct. 27. The exhibit room is located in the lower level of

the Scottish Rite Cathedral and free parking can be found at the Fourth Street entrance to the building.

The Pennsylvania Grange Cookbook, containing 535 pages of "down home" recipes submitted by Grange women, will also be on sale at the convention Oct. 25-28, at \$7 each.

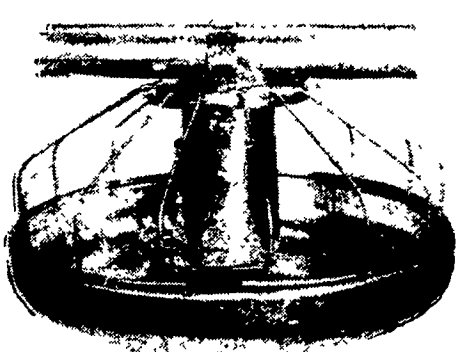

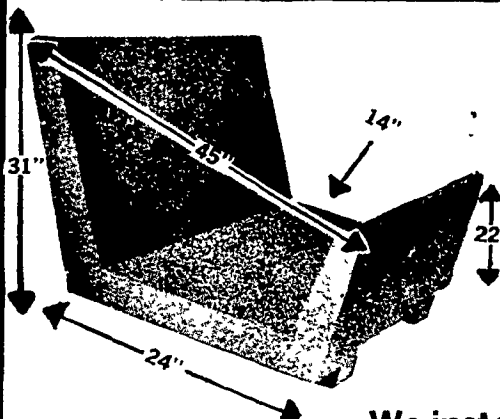
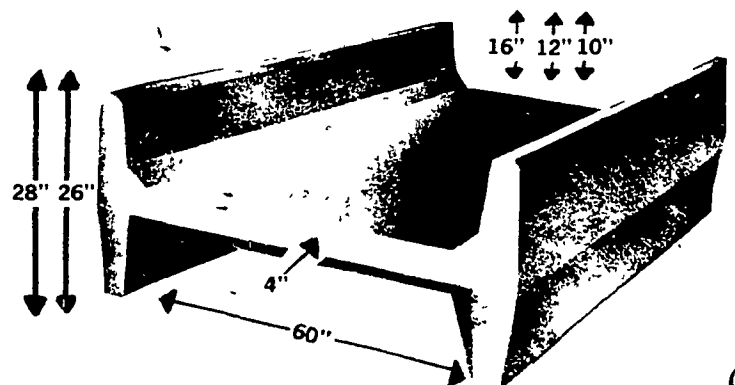
