—Dick Anglestein, of Lancaster Farming, for his help with publicity of chapter activities.

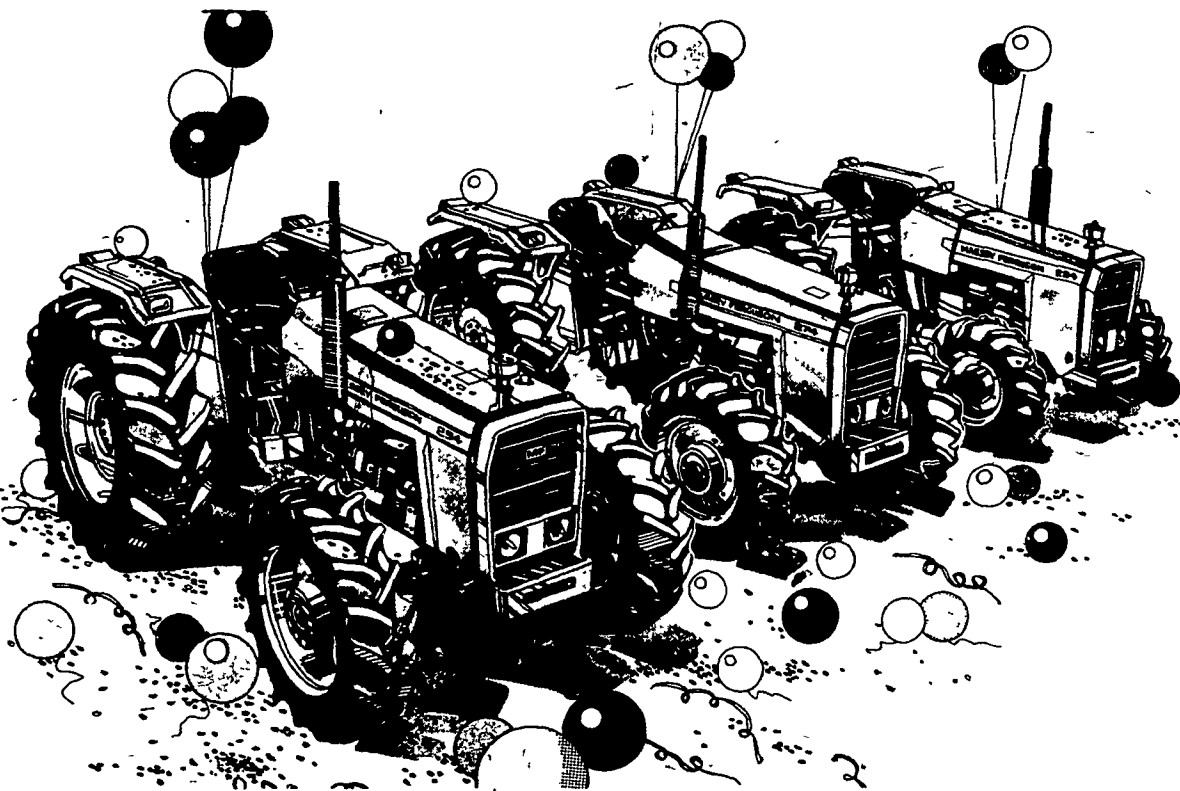
