Compared to previous week's close, slaughter steers and heifers finished the week 50 cents lower. Slaughter cows 1.00-1.50 higher. Bulls 1.00-2.00 lower.

Lower dressed beef prices the first two days this week were generally not reflected in live cattle prices. Good packer demand noted as most were trying to fill their immediate slaughter requirements as not much trading was noted from feedlot sources late last week, over the weekend and early this week. The percentage of yield grade 4 continues relatively high and is a major concern in the trade.

Steers comprised 36 pct. of week's receipts: Heifers 31 pct., cows 5 pct., feeders 27 pct. Four day receipts 10,678, last week 12,533, year ago 11,149.
