

# 61st Nat'l 4-H Congress set for Chicago

CHICAGO, Ill. — More than 1,700 4-H'ers from every state, the District of Columbia and Puerto Rico will gather here for the 61st National 4-H Congress, Nov. 28 through Dec. 2, at the Conrad Hilton Hotel.

With the theme, "4-H Pathways To The Future," the week-long educational program features workshops, assemblies, field trips and recognition events. Delegates were selected by the Extension Service for outstanding achievement in 4-H projects. During the week, 279 scholarships, totalling \$259,000 in educational grants, will be awarded in some 40 4-H project areas.

In workshops focusing on personal development, delegates will

discuss with experts such topics as computers, grooming, handling emergencies, health and nutrition, stress, positive thinking, decision making and selling yourself. Delegates also will meet with 700 leaders of business, industry and education who will be attending the annual event in the Windy City. In addition, eight outstanding 4-H alumni will be honored in the National 4-H alumni recognition program.

Allen A. Schmieder, head of the National Teacher Centers Program at the U.S. Department of Education, founder of "Education Week," a member of four Presidential Commission Task Forces and author of more than 150 publications, will keynote

the opening assembly on Sunday, Nov. 28.

Monday morning's all-Congress breakfast will feature a head table of 50 key leaders in business and government. Also on Monday, delegates will begin discussion groups at their workshops.

International Harvester Company will host an all-Congress luncheon at noon. Entertainment that night, will feature the music of Danny Davis and The Nashville Brass and XTC, sponsored by International Paper Company.

Other special entertainment during the week will include parties hosted by Nabisco Brands Incorporated, The Coca-Cola Company, and Ford Motor Company Fund.

Delegates will tour the Museum of Science and Industry, with transportation provided by Agricultural Equipment Division, J.I. Case Company.

Other tours of Chicago landmarks include The Chicago Board of Trade, Sears Tower, Chicago Mercantile Exchange, Chicago Tribune, Chicago City Hall, Federal Reserve Bank of Chicago, Chicago Fire Academy, International Academy of Merchandising and Design, Playskool Inc., and Continental Illinois Bank and Trust.

Young men and women from 49 states and Puerto Rico will model their ensembles at the National 4-H Fashion Revue hosted by Simplicity Pattern Co., Inc. on

Wednesday at 9:30 a.m., in the Hilton's Grand Ballroom.

On Thursday morning, delegates, leaders and guests will participate in jazzercise and recreation sessions.

An assembly Thursday morning will feature "A Better Way: Extensin Report to America," a multi-media presentation developed by the Extension Service. A visual newsletter of the week's events will be presented by the North Carolina Extension Staff.

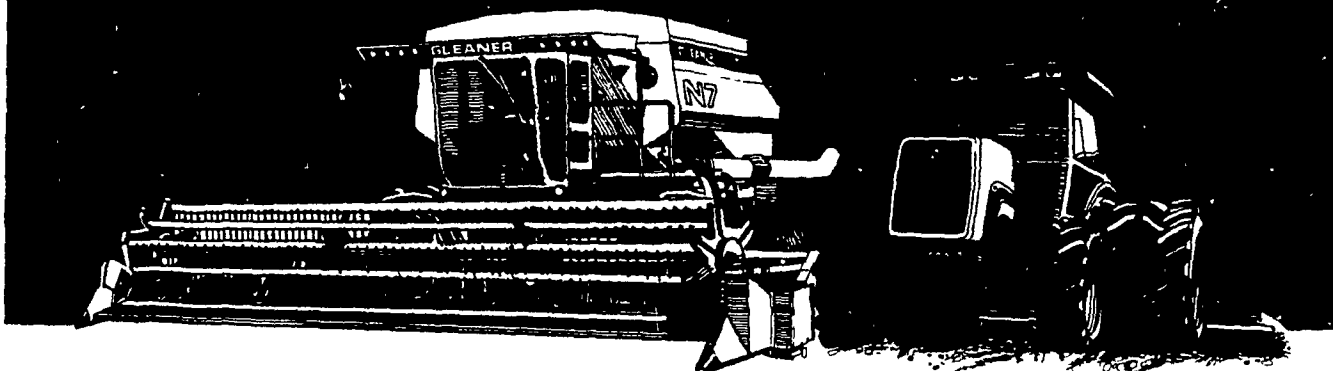

The show features 250 black-and-white and color prints by 4-H members. Also on display will be 100 posters from members in 40 states. These are the only events open to the public.

The Congress will conclude Thursday night with the naming of the six presidential award winners, the annual banquet and a farewell dance.

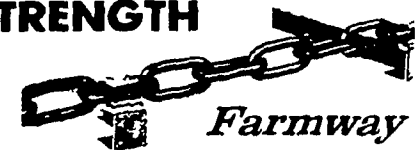
