

Klippenstein, Wingert to head Polled Hereford board

KANSAS CITY, Mo. — Polled Hereford breeders Glen Klippenstein of Maysville, Mo., and George Wingert of Ottawa, Kan., have been elected chairman and vice chairman, respectively, of the board of directors for the American Polled Hereford Association.

Their elections occurred this week during the 60th National Polled Hereford Convention-Show-

Sale held during the American Royal Livestock Show in Kansas City, Mo. New directors assuming four-year terms on the board are Curtis DuVall of DuVall Ranches, Granada, Colo.; James Upfield of Meridian Creek Ranch, Meridian, Texas; and Danny Ross Ingram of Circle 1 Ranch, Water Valley, Miss.

Klippenstein, 45, is partner-

manager of Glenkirk Farms in Maysville. He grew up on a livestock homestead in Canada, but was educated in Pennsylvania. He graduated from Penn State where he was named Mr.

Agriculture, and in 1980 he was named Penn State's Outstanding Alumnus. In 1966, together with partner Kirk Pendleton, Klippenstein founded Glenkirk Farms. In its 16 years of operation,

Glenkirk has had 11 successful production sales, led out six national champions and five national reserve champions, and has sold cattle and semen into 46 states and 16 other countries. Today the Glenkirk partnership includes Ivan Kanak, who joined the group in 1972.

Klippenstein is a sought-after speaker and beef cattle judge, and
